Objectives and investment policy

The fundamental characteristics of the UCITS are as follows:

➤ A UCITS classified as 'Diversified', Echiquier ARTY is a fund which targets medium-term performance through discretionary and opportunity management on fixed-income and equity markets. Fund managers seek to pinpoint the best return/risk ratio offered by instruments produced by issuers in their investment universe.

➤ The composite index 25% MSCI EUROPE + 25% EONIA + 50% Iboxx Euro Corporate 3-5 years may be a representative indicator for the management objective of Echiquier ARTY. It is used solely for information purposes and is calculated in euros, with dividends reinvested.

➤ The management of the fund is based on 'bond picking' for fixed-income markets and on 'stock picking' for equity markets, and relies on discretionary management:

- For equities, these choices entail purchasing (mainly high-yield) French and European shares from any sector. Up to 50% of the fund's net assets are exposed through direct investments or financial instruments.

- For interest rate products, the fund has a minimum exposure of 40% to bonds or negotiable debt securities. Prior to purchase and for monitoring purposes over the life of securities, credit risk is appraised on the basis of research and analysis carried out in-house by La Financière de l'Echiquier and the scores awarded by rating agencies. The percentage of bonds not deemed 'Investment grade' (at least Standard & Poor's BBB- rating or equivalent or considered as such by the management team.) must not exceed 35% of the net assets. The fund invests in OECD bonds, with a maximum of 10% outside the OECD.

➤ The fund capitalises accrued income.

Other information:

➤ Echiquier ARTY may operate in the market for forward financial instruments in order to:

- Reduce the portfolio's exposure to equity markets, and to currency and interest rate risks.

- Exceptionally expose the portfolio to currency, fixed-income and equity risks. Under no circumstances whatsoever does the fund intend to adopt a strategy overexposing the portfolio to these different risks.

➤ Echiquier ARTY is not permitted to invest in securitisation products (ABS, CDO, etc.) or credit derivatives (e.g. CDS) traded over the counter.

➤ This fund may not be appropriate for investors who plan to withdraw their money within 5 years.

➤ Investors may redeem units on any business day, upon request. Redemption applications are centralized each trading day before noon with our centralizer, BNP Paribas Securities Services, and are executed on the basis of the net asset value calculated on the closing prices of the centralizing date.

This information is based on past results for volatility. ➤ **Your UCITS is currently at level 4 on the synthetic indicator** due to its discretionary management and its exposure to European equity markets and fixed-income products. This means that it has a historic weekly volatility over 5 years of between 5% and 10% inclusive. The UCITS is not capital guaranteed.

➤ **The UCITS can also be exposed to the following risks that are insufficiently taken into account by the risk indicator:**

Credit risk: at least 40% of the fund is exposed to money market instruments and bonds. Credit risk, particularly due to investment in 'speculative securities', is the risk that a private issuer's credit rating falls or that it defaults. The value of the debt securities in which the UCITS is invested may fall, causing its net asset value to fall.

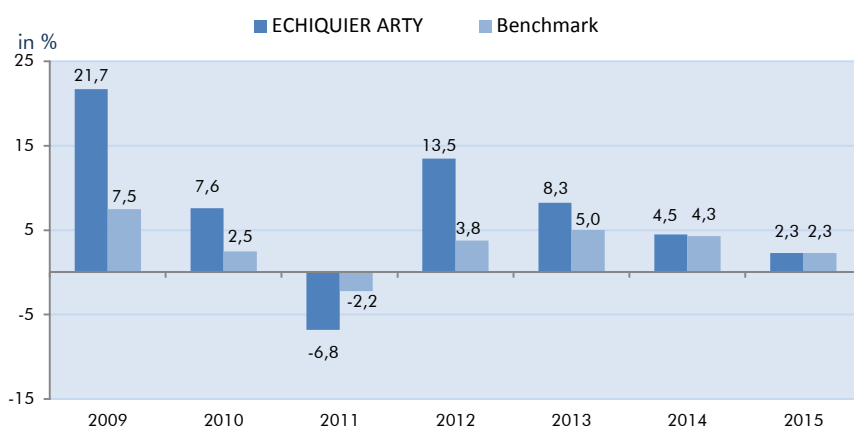
